SCRIPTURES ON JOY

Genesis 31:27 Why did you flee away secretly, and steal away from me, and not tell me; for I might have sent you away with **joy** and songs, with timbrel and harp?

Deuteronomy 28:47 "Because you did not serve the LORD your God with **joy** and gladness of heart, for the abundance of everything,

1 Samuel 18:6 Now it had happened as they were coming *home*, when David was returning from the slaughter of the Philistine, that the women had come out of all the cities of Israel, singing and dancing, to meet King Saul, with tambourines, with **joy**, and with musical instruments.

1 Kings 1:40 And all the people went up after him; and the people played the flutes and rejoiced with great **joy**, so that the earth *seemed* to split with their sound.

1 Kings 8:66 On the eighth day he sent the people away; and they blessed the king, and went to their tents **joyful** and glad of heart for all the good that the LORD had done for His servant David, and for Israel His people.

1 Chronicles 12:40 Moreover those who were near to them, from as far away as Issachar and Zebulun and Naphtali, were bringing food on donkeys and camels, on mules and oxen—provisions of flour and

cakes of figs and cakes of raisins, wine and oil and oxen and sheep abundantly, for *there was* **joy** in Israel.

1 Chronicles 15:16 Then David spoke to the leaders of the Levites to appoint their brethren *to be* the singers accompanied by instruments of music, stringed instruments, harps, and cymbals, by raising the voice with resounding **joy**.

1 Chronicles 15:25 So David, the elders of Israel, and the captains over thousands went to bring up the ark of the covenant of the LORD from the house of Obed-Edom with **joy**.

1 Chronicles 29:17 I know also, my God, that You test the heart and have pleasure in uprightness. As for me, in the uprightness of my heart I have willingly offered all these *things*; and now with **joy** I have seen Your people, who are

present here to offer willingly to You.

2 Chronicles 7:10 On the twenty-third day of the seventh month he sent the people away to their tents, **joyful** and glad of heart for the good that the LORD had done for David, for Solomon, and for His people Israel.

2 Chronicles 20:27 Then they returned, every man of Judah and Jerusalem, with Jehoshaphat in

front of them, to go back to Jerusalem with **joy**, for the LORD had made them rejoice over their enemies.

2 Chronicles 30:26

So there was great **joy** in Jerusalem, for since the time of Solomon the son of David, king of Israel, *there had* been nothing like this in Jerusalem.

Ezra 3:12

But many of the priests and Levites and heads of the fathers' *houses*, old men who had seen the first temple, wept with a loud voice when the foundation of this temple was laid before their eyes. Yet many shouted aloud for **joy**,

Ezra 3:13

so that the people could not discern the noise of the shout of **joy** from the noise of the weeping of the people, for the

people shouted with a loud shout,
and the sound was heard afar off.

Ezra 6:16

Then the children of Israel, the
priests and the Levites and the rest
of the descendants of the
captivity, celebrated the
dedication of this house of God
with **joy**.

Ezra 6:22

And they kept the Feast of
Unleavened Bread seven days

with **joy**; for the LORD made
them **joyful**, and turned the heart
of the king of Assyria toward
them, to strengthen their hands in
the work of the house of God, the
God of Israel.

Nehemiah 8:10

Then he said to them, "Go your
way, eat the fat, drink the sweet,
and send portions to those for
whom nothing is prepared;
for *this day is holy* to our Lord. Do

not sorrow, for the **joy** of the LORD is your strength.”

Nehemiah 12:43 Also that day they offered great sacrifices, and rejoiced, for God had made them rejoice with great **joy**; the women and the children also rejoiced, so that the **joy** of Jerusalem was heard afar off.

Esther 5:9 So Haman went out that day **joyful** and with a glad heart; but when Haman saw Mordecai in the king's gate, and that he did

not stand or tremble before him, he was filled with indignation against Mordecai.

Esther 8:16 The Jews had light and gladness, **joy** and honor.

Esther 8:17 And in every province and city, wherever the king's command and decree came, the Jews had **joy** and gladness, a feast and a holiday. Then many of the people of the land became Jews,

because fear of the Jews fell upon them.

Esther 9:22 As the days on which the Jews had rest from their enemies, as the month which was turned from sorrow to **joy** for them, and from mourning to a holiday; that they should make them days of feasting and **joy**, of sending presents to one another and gifts to the poor.

Job 3:7 Oh, may that night be barren! May no **joyful** shout come into it!

Job 8:19 Behold, this is the **joy** of His way, And out of the earth others will grow.

Job 20:5 That the triumphing of the wicked is short, And the **joy** of the hypocrite is *but* for a moment?

Job 29:13 The blessing of a perishing *man* came upon me,

And I caused the widow's heart to sing for **joy**.

Job 33:26 He shall pray to God, and He will delight in him, He shall see His face with **joy**, For He restores to man His righteousness.

Job 38:7 When the morning stars sang together, And all the sons of God shouted for **joy**?

Psalms 5:11 But let all those rejoice who put their trust in You; Let them ever shout for **joy**, because

You defend them; Let those also who love Your name Be **joyful** in You.

Psalms 16:11 You will show me the path of life; In Your presence *is* fullness of **joy**; At Your right hand *are* pleasures forevermore.

Psalms 21:1 The king shall have **joy** in Your strength, O LORD; And in Your salvation how greatly shall he rejoice!

Psalm 27:6 And now my head shall be lifted up above my enemies all around me; Therefore I will offer sacrifices of **joy** in His tabernacle; I will sing, yes, I will sing praises to the LORD.

Psalm 30:5 For His anger *is but for* a moment, His favor *is for* life; Weeping may endure for a night, But **joy** *comes* in the morning.

Psalm 32:1 Blessed *is he* whose transgression is forgiven, *Whose* sin is covered.

Psalm 32:11 Be glad in the LORD and rejoice, you righteous; And shout for **joy**, all *you* upright in heart!

Psalm 33:3 Sing to Him a new song; Play skillfully with a shout of **joy**.

Psalm 35:9 And my soul shall be **joyful** in the LORD; It shall rejoice in His salvation.

Psalm 35:27 Let them shout for **joy** and be glad, Who favor my righteous cause; And let them say continually, "Let the LORD be magnified, Who has pleasure in the prosperity of His servant."

Psalm 42:4 When I remember these *things*, I pour out my soul within me. For I used to go with the multitude; I went with them to

the house of God, With the voice of **joy** and praise, With a multitude that kept a pilgrim feast.

Psalm 43:4 Then I will go to the altar of God, To God my exceeding **joy**; And on the harp I will praise You, O God, my God.

Psalm 48:2 Beautiful in elevation, The **joy** of the whole earth, *Is Mount Zion on the sides of the north*, The city of the great King.

Psalm 51:8 Make me hear **joy** and gladness, *That* the bones You have broken may rejoice.

Psalm 51:12 Restore to me the **joy** of Your salvation, And uphold me *by Your* generous Spirit.

Psalm 63:1 O God, You *are* my God; Early will I seek You; My soul thirsts for You; My flesh longs for You In a dry and thirsty land Where there is no water.

Psalm 63:5 My soul shall be satisfied as with marrow and fatness, And my mouth shall praise *You* with **joyful** lips.

Psalm 65:13 The pastures are clothed with flocks; The valleys also are covered with grain; They shout for **joy**, they also sing.

Psalm 66:1 Make a **joyful** shout to God, all the earth!

Psalm 67:4 Oh, let the nations be glad and sing for **joy**! For You

shall judge the people righteously,
And govern the nations on
earth. *Selah*

Psalm 81:1 Sing aloud to God our
strength; Make a **joyful** shout to
the God of Jacob.

Psalm 89:15 Blessed *are* the
people who know the **joyful**
sound! They walk, O LORD, in the
light of Your countenance.

Psalm 95:1 Oh come, let us sing
to the LORD! Let us shout **joyfully**
to the Rock of our salvation.

Psalm 95:2 Let us come before
His presence with thanksgiving;
Let us shout **joyfully** to Him with
psalms.

Psalm 96:12 Let the field be **joyful**,
and all that *is* in it. Then all the
trees of the woods will rejoice

Psalm 98:4 Shout **joy**fully to the LORD, all the earth; Break forth in song, rejoice, and sing praises.

Psalm 98:6 With trumpets and the sound of a horn; Shout **joy**fully before the LORD, the King.

Psalm 98:8 Let the rivers clap *their* hands; Let the hills be **joy**ful together

Psalm 100:1 Make a **joy**ful shout to the LORD, all you lands!

Psalm 105:43 He brought out His people with **joy**, His chosen ones with gladness.

Psalm 106:1 Praise the LORD! Oh, give thanks to the LORD, for *He* is good! For His mercy *endures* forever.

Psalm 113:9 He grants the barren woman a home, Like a **joy**ful mother of children. Praise the LORD!

Psalm 122:1 I was glad when they said to me, "Let us go into the house of the LORD."

Psalm 126:1 When the LORD brought back the captivity of Zion, We were like those who dream.

Psalm 126:5

Those who sow in tears Shall reap in **joy**.

Psalm 132:9 Let Your priests be clothed with righteousness, And let Your saints shout for **joy**.

Psalm 132:16

I will also clothe her priests with salvation, And her saints shall shout aloud for **joy**.

Psalm 137:6

If I do not remember you, Let my tongue cling to the roof of my mouth— If I do not exalt Jerusalem Above my chief **joy**.

Psalm 149:2 Let Israel rejoice in their Maker; Let the children of Zion be **joyful** in their King.

Psalm 149:5 Let the saints be **joyful** in glory; Let them sing aloud on their beds.

Proverbs 12:20 Deceit is in the heart of those who devise evil, But counselors of peace have **joy**.

Proverbs 14:10 The heart knows its own bitterness, And a stranger does not share its **joy**.

Proverbs 15:21 Folly is **joy** to him who is destitute of discernment, But a man of understanding walks uprightly.

Proverbs 15:23 A man has **joy** by the answer of his mouth, And a word *spoken* in due season, how good *it is!*

Proverbs 17:21 He who begets a scoffer *does so* to his sorrow, And the father of a fool has no **joy**.

Proverbs 21:15 *It is* a **joy** for the just to do justice, But

destruction *will come* to the workers of iniquity.

Ecclesiastes 2:26 For God gives wisdom and knowledge and **joy** to a man who *is* good in His sight; but to the sinner He gives the work of gathering and collecting, that he may give to *him who is* good before God. This also *is* vanity and grasping for the wind.

Ecclesiastes 5:20 For he will not dwell unduly on the days of his

life, because God keeps *him* busy with the **joy** of his heart.

Ecclesiastes 7:14 In the day of prosperity be **joyful**, But in the day of adversity consider: Surely God has appointed the one as well as the other, So that man can find out nothing *that will come* after him.

Ecclesiastes 9:7 Go, eat your bread with **joy**, And drink your wine with a merry heart; For God has already accepted your works.

Ecclesiastes 9:9 Live **joy**fully with the wife whom you love all the days of your vain life which He has given you under the sun, all your days of vanity; for that *is* your portion in life, and in the labor which you perform under the sun.

Isaiah 9:3 You have multiplied the nation *And* increased its **joy**; They rejoice before You According to the **joy** of harvest, As *men* rejoice when they divide the spoil.

Isaiah 9:17 Therefore the Lord will have no **joy** in their young men, Nor have mercy on their fatherless and widows; For everyone *is* a hypocrite and an evildoer, And every mouth speaks folly. For all this His anger is not turned away, But His hand *is* stretched out still.

Isaiah 12:3 Therefore with **joy** you will draw water From the wells of salvation.

Isaiah 16:10 Gladness is taken away, And **joy** from the plentiful

field; In the vineyards there will be no singing, Nor will there be shouting; No treaders will tread out wine in the presses; I have made their shouting cease.

Isaiah 22:2 You who are full of noise, A tumultuous city, a **joyous** city? Your slain *men are* not slain with the sword, Nor dead in battle.

Isaiah 22:13 But instead, **joy** and gladness, Slaying oxen and killing sheep, Eating meat and drinking

wine: "Let us eat and drink, for tomorrow we die!"

Isaiah 23:7 *Is this* your **joyous city**, Whose antiquity *is* from ancient days, Whose feet carried her far off to dwell?

Isaiah 24:8 The mirth of the tambourine ceases, The noise of the jubilant ends, The **joy** of the harp ceases.

Isaiah 24:11 *There is a cry for wine in the streets, All **joy** is darkened, The mirth of the land is gone.*

Isaiah 29:19 *The humble also shall increase **their joy** in the LORD, And the poor among men shall rejoice In the Holy One of Israel.*

Isaiah 32:13 *On the land of my people will come up thorns *and* briers, Yes, on all the happy homes *in* the **joyous** city;*

Isaiah 32:14 *Because the palaces will be forsaken, The bustling city will be deserted. The forts and towers will become lairs forever, A **joy** of wild donkeys, a pasture of flocks—*

Isaiah 35:2 *It shall blossom abundantly and rejoice, Even with **joy** and singing. The glory of Lebanon shall be given to it, The excellence of Carmel and Sharon. They shall see the glory of*

the LORD, The excellency of our God.

Isaiah 35:10 And the ransomed of the LORD shall return, And come to Zion with singing, With everlasting **joy** on their heads. They shall obtain **joy** and gladness, And sorrow and sighing shall flee away.

Isaiah 49:13 Sing, O heavens! Be **joyful**, O earth! And break out in singing, O mountains! For

the LORD has comforted His people, And will have mercy on His afflicted.

Isaiah 51:3 For the LORD will comfort Zion, He will comfort all her waste places; He will make her wilderness like Eden, And her desert like the garden of the LORD; **Joy** and gladness will be found in it, Thanksgiving and the voice of melody.

Isaiah 51:11 So the ransomed of the LORD shall return, And come to Zion with singing, With everlasting **joy** on their heads. They shall obtain **joy** and gladness; Sorrow and sighing shall flee away.

Isaiah 52:9 Break forth into **joy**, sing together, You waste places of Jerusalem! For the LORD has comforted His people, He has redeemed Jerusalem.

Isaiah 55:12 "For you shall go out with **joy**, And be led out with peace; The mountains and the hills Shall break forth into singing before you, And all the trees of the field shall clap *their* hands.

Isaiah 56:7 Even them I will bring to My holy mountain, And make them **joyful** in My house of prayer. Their burnt offerings and their sacrifices *Will be* accepted on My altar; For My house shall be called a house of prayer for all nations."

Isaiah 60:5 Then you shall see and become radiant, And your heart shall swell with **joy**; Because the abundance of the sea shall be turned to you, The wealth of the Gentiles shall come to you.

Isaiah 60:15 "Whereas you have been forsaken and hated, So that no one went through *you*, I will make you an eternal excellence, A **joy** of many generations.

Isaiah 61:3 To console those who mourn in Zion, To give them beauty for ashes, The oil of **joy** for mourning, The garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; That they may be called trees of righteousness, The planting of the LORD, that He may be glorified."

Isaiah 61:7 Instead of your shame *you shall have double honor*, And *instead of confusion* they shall rejoice in their portion. Therefore in their

land they shall possess double;
Everlasting **joy** shall be theirs.

Isaiah 61:10 I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, My soul shall be **joyful** in my God; For He has clothed me with the garments of salvation, He has covered me with the robe of righteousness, As a bridegroom decks *himself* with ornaments, And as a bride adorns *herself* with her jewels.

Isaiah 65:14 Behold, My servants shall sing for **joy** of heart, But you

shall cry for sorrow of heart, And wail for grief of spirit.

Isaiah 65:18

But be glad and rejoice forever in what I create; For behold, I create Jerusalem *as* a rejoicing, And her people a **joy**.

Isaiah 65:19 I will rejoice in Jerusalem, And **joy** in My people; The voice of weeping shall no longer be heard in her, Nor the voice of crying.

Isaiah 66:5 Hear the word of the LORD, You who tremble at His word: "Your brethren who hated you, Who cast you out for My name's sake, said, 'Let the LORD be glorified, That we may see your **joy**.' But they shall be ashamed."

Isaiah 66:10 "Rejoice with Jerusalem, And be glad with her, all you who love her; Rejoice for **joy** with her, all you who mourn for her;

Jeremiah 15:16 Your words were found, and I ate them, And Your word was to me the **joy** and rejoicing of my heart; For I am called by Your name, O LORD God of hosts.

Jeremiah 31:13 "Then shall the virgin rejoice in the dance, And the young men and the old, together; For I will turn their mourning to **joy**, Will comfort them, And make them rejoice rather than sorrow.

Jeremiah 33:9 Then it shall be to Me a name of **joy**, a praise, and an honor before all nations of the earth, who shall hear all the good that I do to them; they shall fear and tremble for all the goodness and all the prosperity that I provide for it.'

Jeremiah 33:11 the voice of **joy** and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride, the voice of those who will say: "Praise the LORD of hosts, For

the LORD *is* good, For His mercy *endures* forever"— *and* of those *who will* bring the sacrifice of praise into the house of the LORD. For I will cause the captives of the land to return as at the first,' says the LORD.

Jeremiah 48:33 **Joy** and gladness are taken From the plentiful field And from the land of Moab; I have caused wine to fail from the winepresses; No one will tread with **joyous** shouting!

Jeremiah 49:25 Why is the city of praise not deserted, the city of My **joy**?

Jeremiah 51:48 Then the heavens and the earth and all that *is* in them Shall sing **joy**ously over Babylon; For the plunderers shall come to her from the north," says the LORD.

Lamentations 2:15 All who pass by clap *their* hands at you; They hiss and shake their heads At the daughter of Jerusalem: "*Is* this the

city that is called 'The perfection of beauty, The **joy** of the whole earth'?"

Lamentations 5:15 The **joy** of our heart has ceased; Our dance has turned into mourning.

Ezekiel 24:25 'And you, son of man—*will it not be* in the day when I take from them their stronghold, their **joy** and their glory, the desire of their eyes, and that on which they set their minds, their sons and their daughters:

Ezekiel 36:5 therefore thus says the Lord GOD: "Surely I have spoken in My burning jealousy against the rest of the nations and against all Edom, who gave My land to themselves as a possession, with wholehearted **joy** and spiteful minds, in order to plunder its open country."

Hosea 9:1 Do not rejoice, O Israel, with **joy** like *other* peoples, For you have played the harlot against your God. You have made

love *for* hire on every threshing floor.

Joel 1:12 The vine has dried up, And the fig tree has withered; The pomegranate tree, The palm tree also, And the apple tree— All the trees of the field are withered; Surely **joy** has withered away from the sons of men.

Joel 1:16 Is not the food cut off before our eyes, **Joy** and gladness from the house of our God?

Habakkuk 3:18 Yet I will rejoice in the LORD, I will **joy** in the God of my salvation.

Zephaniah 3:14 Sing, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O Israel! Be glad and rejoice with all *your* heart, O daughter of Jerusalem!

Zechariah 2:6 "Up, up! Flee from the land of the north," says the LORD; "for I have spread you abroad like the four winds of heaven," says the LORD.

Zechariah 8:19 "Thus says the LORD of hosts: 'The fast of the fourth *month*, The fast of the fifth, The fast of the seventh, And the fast of the tenth, Shall be **joy** and gladness and cheerful feasts For the house of Judah. Therefore love truth and peace.'

Matthew 2:10 When they saw the star, they rejoiced with exceedingly great **joy**.

Matthew 13:20 But he who received the seed on stony places,

this is he who hears the word and immediately receives it with **joy**;

Matthew 13:44 "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field, which a man found and hid; and for **joy** over it he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field.

Matthew 25:21 His lord said to him, 'Well *done*, good and faithful servant; you were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler

over many things. Enter into the **joy** of your lord.'

Matthew 25:23 His lord said to him, 'Well *done*, good and faithful servant; you have been faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the **joy** of your lord.'

Matthew 28:8 So they went out quickly from the tomb with fear and great **joy**, and ran to bring His disciples word.

Luke 1:14 And you will have **joy** and gladness, and many will rejoice at his birth.

Luke 1:44 For indeed, as soon as the voice of your greeting sounded in my ears, the babe leaped in my womb for **joy**.

Luke 2:10 Then the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid, for behold, I bring you good tidings of great **joy** which will be to all people.

Luke 6:23 Rejoice in that day and leap for **joy**! For indeed your reward *is* great in heaven, For in like manner their fathers did to the prophets.

Luke 8:13 But the ones on the rock *are those* who, when they hear, receive the word with **joy**; and these have no root, who believe for a while and in time of temptation fall away.

Luke 10:17 Then the seventy returned with **joy**, saying, "Lord,

even the demons are subject to us in Your name.”

Luke 15:7 I say to you that likewise there will be more **joy** in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine just persons who need no repentance.

Luke 15:10 Likewise, I say to you, there is **joy** in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents.”

Luke 19:6 So he made haste and came down, and received Him **joyfully**.

Luke 24:41 But while they still did not believe for **joy**, and marveled, He said to them, “Have you any food here?”

Luke 24:52 And they worshiped Him, and returned to Jerusalem with great **joy**,

John 3:29 He who has the bride is the bridegroom; but the friend of the bridegroom, who stands and

hears him, rejoices greatly because of the bridegroom's voice.

Therefore this **joy** of mine is fulfilled.

John 15:9 "As the Father loved Me, I also have loved you; abide in My love.

John 15:11 "These things I have spoken to you, that My **joy** may remain in you, and *that* your **joy** may be full.

John 16:16 "A little while, and you will not see Me; and again a little

while, and you will see Me, because I go to the Father."

John 16:20 Most assuredly, I say to you that you will weep and lament, but the world will rejoice; and you will be sorrowful, but your sorrow will be turned into **joy**.

John 16:21 A woman, when she is in labor, has sorrow because her hour has come; but as soon as she has given birth to the child, she no longer remembers the anguish,

for **joy** that a human being has been born into the world.

John 16:22 Therefore you now have sorrow; but I will see you again and your heart will rejoice, and your **joy** no one will take from you.

John 16:24 Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your **joy** may be full.

John 17:13 But now I come to You, and these things I speak in the

world, that they may have My **joy** fulfilled in themselves.

Acts 2:28 You have made known to me the ways of life; You will make me full of **joy** in Your presence.'

Acts 8:8 And there was great **joy** in that city.

Acts 13:52 And the disciples were filled with **joy** and with the Holy Spirit.

Acts 15:3 So, being sent on their way by the church, they passed through Phoenicia and Samaria, describing the conversion of the Gentiles; and they caused great **joy** to all the brethren.

Acts 20:24 But none of these things move me; nor do I count my life dear to myself, so that I may finish my race with **joy**, and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God.

Romans 14:17 for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and **joy** in the Holy Spirit.

Romans 15:13 Now may the God of hope fill you with all **joy** and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Romans 15:32 that I may come to you with **joy** by the will of God, and may be refreshed together with you.

2 Corinthians 1:24 Not that we have dominion over your faith, but are fellow workers for your **joy**; for by faith you stand.

2 Corinthians 2:3 And I wrote this very thing to you, lest, when I came, I should have sorrow over those from whom I ought to have **joy**, having confidence in you all that my **joy** is *the joy* of you all.

2 Corinthians 7:4 Great *is* my boldness of speech toward you, great *is* my boasting on your

behalf. I am filled with comfort. I am exceedingly **joyful** in all our tribulation.

2 Corinthians 7:13 Therefore we have been comforted in your comfort. And we rejoiced exceedingly more for the **joy** of Titus, because his spirit has been refreshed by you all.

2 Corinthians 8:2 that in a great trial of affliction the abundance of their **joy** and their deep poverty

abounded in the riches of their liberality.

Galatians 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, **joy**, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,

Philippians 1:4 always in every prayer of mine making request for you all with **joy**,

Philippians 1:25 And being confident of this, I know that I shall remain and continue with

you all for your progress and **joy** of faith,

Philippians 2:2 fulfill my **joy** by being like-minded, having the same love, *being* of one accord, of one mind.

Philippians 4:1 Therefore, my beloved and longed-for brethren, my **joy** and crown, so stand fast in the Lord, beloved.

Psalm 90:14 Oh, satisfy us early with Your mercy, That we may **rejoice** and be glad all our days!

Psalm 96:11 Let the heavens **rejoice**, and let the earth

be glad; Let the sea roar, and all its fullness;

Psalm 96:12 Let the field be joyful, and all that *is* in it. Then all the trees of the woods will **rejoice**

Psalm 97:1 The LORD reigns; Let the earth **rejoice**; Let the multitude of isles be glad!

Psalm 97:8 Zion hears and is glad, And the daughters of Judah **rejoice** Because of Your judgments, O LORD.

Psalm 97:12 **Rejoice** in the LORD,
you righteous, And give thanks at
the remembrance of His holy
name.

Psalm 98:4 Shout joyfully to
the LORD, all the earth; Break forth
in song, **rejoice**, and sing praises.

Psalm 104:31 May the glory of
the LORD endure forever; May
the LORD **rejoice** in His works.

Psalm 105:3 Glory in His holy
name; Let the hearts of
those **rejoice** who seek the LORD!

Psalm 106:5 That I may see the
benefit of Your chosen ones, That I
may **rejoice** in the gladness of
Your nation, That I may glory with
Your inheritance.

Psalm 107:42 The righteous
see *it* and **rejoice**, And all iniquity
stops its mouth.

Psalm 108:7 God has spoken in His holiness: "I will **rejoice**; I will divide Shechem And measure out the Valley of Succoth.

Psalm 109:28 Let them curse, but You bless; When they arise, let them be ashamed, But let Your servant **rejoice**.

Psalm 118:24 This *is* the day the LORD has made; We will **rejoice** and be glad in it.

Psalm 119:14 I have **rejoiced** in the way of Your testimonies, As *much as* in all riches.

Psalm 119:162 I **rejoice** at Your word As one who finds great treasure.

Psalm 149:2 Let Israel **rejoice** in their Maker; Let the children of Zion be joyful in their King.

Proverbs 2:14 Who **rejoice** in doing evil, *And* delight in the perversity of the wicked;

Proverbs 5:18 Let your fountain be blessed, And **rejoice** with the wife of your youth.

Proverbs 11:10 When it goes well with the righteous, the city **rejoices**; And when the wicked perish, *there is* jubilation.

Proverbs 13:9 The light of the righteous **rejoices**, But the lamp of the wicked will be put out.

Proverbs 15:30 The light of the eyes **rejoices** the heart, *And a*

good report makes the bones healthy.

Proverbs 23:15 My son, if your heart is wise, My heart will **rejoice**—indeed, I myself;

Proverbs 23:16 Yes, my inmost being will **rejoice** When your lips speak right things.

Proverbs 23:24 The father of the righteous will greatly **rejoice**, And he who begets a wise *child* will delight in him.

Proverbs 23:25 Let your father and your mother be glad, And let her who bore you **rejoice**.

Proverbs 24:17

Do not **rejoice** when your enemy falls, And do not let your heart be glad when he stumbles;

Proverbs 28:12 When the righteous **rejoice**, *there is* great glory; But when the wicked arise, men hide themselves.

Proverbs 29:2 When the righteous are in authority, the people **rejoice**; But when a wicked *man* rules, the people groan.

Proverbs 29:3 Whoever loves wisdom makes his father **rejoice**, But a companion of harlots wastes *his* wealth.

Proverbs 29:6 By transgression an evil man is snared, But the righteous sings and **rejoices**.

Proverbs 31:25 Strength and honor *are* her clothing; She shall **rejoice** in time to come.

Ecclesiastes 2:10 Whatever my eyes desired I did not keep from them. I did not withhold my heart from any pleasure, For my heart **rejoiced** in all my labor; And this was my reward from all my labor.

Ecclesiastes 3:12 I know that nothing *is* better for them than

to **rejoice**, and to do good in their lives,

Ecclesiastes 3:22 So I perceived that nothing *is* better than that a man should **rejoice** in his own works, for that *is* his heritage. For who can bring him to see what will happen after him?

Ecclesiastes 4:16 *There was* no end of all the people over whom he was made king; Yet those who come afterward will not **rejoice** in

him. Surely this also *is* vanity and grasping for the wind.

Ecclesiastes 5:19 As for every man to whom God has given riches and wealth, and given him power to eat of it, to receive his heritage and **rejoice** in his labor—
this *is* the gift of God.

Ecclesiastes 11:8 But if a man lives many years *And* **rejoices** in them all, Yet let him remember the days

of darkness, For they will be many. All that is coming *is* vanity.

Ecclesiastes 11:9 **Rejoice**, O young man, in your youth, And let your heart cheer you in the days of your youth; Walk in the ways of your heart, And in the sight of your eyes; But know that for all these God will bring you into judgment.

Song of Solomon 1:4 Draw me away! We will run after you. The

king has brought me into his chambers. We will be glad and **rejoice** in you. We will remember your love more than wine. Rightly do they love you.

Isaiah 8:6 "Inasmuch as these people refused The waters of Shiloah that flow softly,
And **rejoice** in Rezin and in Remaliah's son;

Isaiah 9:3 You have multiplied the nation *And* increased its joy;

They **rejoice** before You
According to the joy of harvest,
As *men* **rejoice** when they divide the spoil.

Isaiah 13:3 I have commanded My sanctified ones; I have also called My mighty ones for My anger—
Those who **rejoice** in My exaltation."

Isaiah 14:8 Indeed the cypress trees **rejoice** over you, *And* the cedars of Lebanon, *Saying*, 'Since

you were cut down, No woodsman has come up against us.'

Isaiah 14:29 "Do not **rejoice**, all you of Philistia, Because the rod that struck you is broken; For out of the serpent's roots will come forth a viper, And its offspring *will be* a fiery flying serpent.

Isaiah 23:12 And He said, "You will **rejoice** no more, O you oppressed virgin daughter of

Sidon. Arise, cross over to Cyprus; There also you will have no rest."

Isaiah 25:9 And it will be said in that day: "Behold, this *is* our God; We have waited for Him, and He will save us. This *is* the LORD; We have waited for Him; We will be glad and **rejoice** in His salvation."

Isaiah 29:19 The humble also shall increase *their* joy in the LORD, And the poor among men

shall **rejoice** In the Holy One of Israel.

Isaiah 35:1 The wilderness and the wasteland shall be glad for them, And the desert shall **rejoice** and blossom as the rose;

Isaiah 35:2 It shall blossom abundantly and **rejoice**, Even with joy and singing. The glory of Lebanon shall be given to it, The excellence of Carmel and Sharon. They shall see the glory of

the LORD, The excellency of our God.

Isaiah 41:16 You shall winnow them, the wind shall carry them away, And the whirlwind shall scatter them; You shall **rejoice** in the LORD, *And* glory in the Holy One of Israel.

Isaiah 43:14 Thus says the LORD, your Redeemer, The Holy One of Israel: "For your sake I will send to Babylon, And bring them all down

as fugitives— The Chaldeans,
who **rejoice** in their ships.

Isaiah 61:7 Instead of your
shame *you shall*
have double honor, And *instead*
of confusion they shall **rejoice** in
their portion. Therefore in their
land they shall possess double;
Everlasting joy shall be theirs.

Isaiah 61:10 I will greatly **rejoice** in
the LORD, My soul shall be joyful in
my God; For He has clothed me

with the garments of salvation, He
has covered me with the robe of
righteousness, As a bridegroom
decks *himself* with ornaments, And
as a bride adorns *herself* with her
jewels.

Isaiah 62:5 For *as* a young man
marries a virgin, So shall your sons
marry you; And *as* the
bridegroom **rejoices** over the
bride, So shall your
God **rejoice** over you.

Isaiah 64:5 You meet him
who **rejoices** and does
righteousness, *Who* remembers
You in Your ways. You are indeed
angry, for we have sinned— In
these ways we continue; And we
need to be saved.

Isaiah 65:13 Therefore thus says
the Lord GOD: “Behold, My
servants shall eat, But you shall be
hungry; Behold, My servants shall
drink, But you shall be thirsty;

Behold, My servants shall **rejoice**,
But you shall be ashamed;

Isaiah 65:18 But be glad
and **rejoice** forever in what I
create; For behold, I create
Jerusalem *as* a rejoicing, And her
people a joy.

Isaiah 65:19 I will **rejoice** in
Jerusalem, And joy in My people;
The voice of weeping shall no
longer be heard in her, Nor the
voice of crying.

Isaiah 66:10 "**Rejoice** with Jerusalem, And be glad with her, all you who love her; **Rejoice** for joy with her, all you who mourn for her;

Isaiah 66:14 When you see *this*, your heart shall **rejoice**, And your bones shall flourish like grass; The hand of the LORD shall be known to His servants, And *His* indignation to His enemies.

Jeremiah 11:15 "What has My beloved to do in My house, Having done lewd deeds with many? And the holy flesh has passed from you. When you do evil, then you **rejoice**.

Jeremiah 15:17 I did not sit in the assembly of the mockers, Nor did I **rejoice**; I sat alone because of Your hand, For You have filled me with indignation.

Jeremiah 31:4 Again I will build you, and you shall be rebuilt, O virgin of Israel! You shall again be adorned with your tambourines, And shall go forth in the dances of those who **rejoice**.

Jeremiah 31:13 "Then shall the virgin **rejoice** in the dance, And the young men and the old, together; For I will turn their mourning to joy, Will comfort them, And make them **rejoice** rather than sorrow.

Jeremiah 32:41 Yes, I will **rejoice** over them to do them good, and I will assuredly plant them in this land, with all My heart and with all My soul.'

Jeremiah 50:11 "Because you were glad, because you **rejoiced**, You destroyers of My heritage, Because you have grown fat like a heifer threshing grain, And you bellow like bulls,

Jeremiah 51:39 In their excitement
I will prepare their feasts; I will
make them drunk, That they
may **rejoice**, And sleep a
perpetual sleep And not awake,"
says the LORD.

Lamentations 2:17 The LORD has
done what He purposed; He has
fulfilled His word Which He
commanded in days of old. He has
thrown down and has not pitied,
And He has caused an enemy
to **rejoice** over you; He has

exalted the horn of your
adversaries.

Lamentations 4:21 **Rejoice** and be
glad, O daughter of
Edom, *You* who dwell in the land
of Uz! The cup shall also pass over
to you And you shall become
drunk and make yourself naked.

Ezekiel 7:12 The time has come,
The day draws near. 'Let not the
buyer **rejoice**, Nor the seller
mourn, For wrath *is* on their whole
multitude.

Ezekiel 25:6 'For thus says the Lord GOD: "Because you clapped *your* hands, stamped your feet, and **rejoiced** in heart with all your disdain for the land of Israel,

Ezekiel 35:14 'Thus says the Lord GOD: "The whole earth will **rejoice** when I make you desolate.

Ezekiel 35:15 As you **rejoiced** because the inheritance of the house of Israel was desolate, so I will do to you; you shall be

desolate, O Mount Seir, as well as all of Edom—all of it! Then they shall know that I *am* the LORD." '

Hosea 9:1 Do not **rejoice**, O Israel, with joy like *other* peoples, For you have played the harlot against your God. You have made love *for* hire on every threshing floor.

Joel 2:21 Fear not, O land; Be glad and **rejoice**, For the LORD has done marvelous things!

Joel 2:23 Be glad then, you children of Zion, And **rejoice** in the LORD your God; For He has given you the former rain faithfully, And He will cause the rain to come down for you— The former rain, And the latter rain in the first *month*.

Amos 6:13 You who **rejoice** over Lo Debar, Who say, "Have we not taken Karnaim for ourselves By our own strength?"

Obadiah 1:12 "But you should not have gazed on the day of your brother In the day of his captivity; Nor should you have **rejoiced** over the children of Judah In the day of their destruction; Nor should you have spoken proudly In the day of distress.

Micah 7:8 Do not **rejoice** over me, my enemy; When I fall, I will arise; When I sit in darkness, The LORD *will be* a light to me.

Habakkuk 1:15 They take up all of them with a hook, They catch them in their net, And gather them in their dragnet. Therefore they **rejoice** and are glad.

Habakkuk 3:18 Yet I will **rejoice** in the LORD, I will joy in the God of my salvation.

Zephaniah 3:11 In that day you shall not be shamed for any of your deeds In which you transgress against Me; For then I will take away from your midst

Those who **rejoice** in your pride, And you shall no longer be haughty In My holy mountain.

Zephaniah 3:14 Sing, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O Israel! Be glad and **rejoice** with all *your* heart, O daughter of Jerusalem!

Zephaniah 3:17 The LORD your God in your midst, The Mighty One, will save; He will **rejoice** over you with gladness, He will quiet *you* with His love, He will **rejoice** over you with singing."

[Zechariah 2:10](#) "Sing and **rejoice**,
O daughter of Zion! For behold, I
am coming and I will dwell in your
midst," says the LORD.

[Zechariah 4:10](#) For who has
despised the day of small things?
For these seven **rejoice** to see The
plumb line in the hand of

the LORD, Which scan to and fro
throughout the whole earth."

[Zechariah 9:9](#) "**Rejoice** greatly, O
daughter of Zion! Shout, O

daughter of Jerusalem! Behold,
your King is coming to you;
He *is* just and having salvation,
Lowly and riding on a donkey, A
colt, the foal of a donkey.

[Zechariah 10:7](#) *Those of Ephraim*
shall be like a mighty man, And
their heart shall **rejoice** as if with
wine. Yes, their children shall
see *it* and be glad; Their heart
shall **rejoice** in the LORD.

Matthew 2:10 When they saw the star, they **rejoiced** with exceedingly great joy.

Matthew 5:12 **Rejoice** and be exceedingly glad, for great *is* your reward in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you.

Matthew 18:13 And if he should find it, assuredly, I say to you, he **rejoices** more over that *sheep* than over the ninety-nine that did not go astray.

Matthew 28:9 And as they went to tell His disciples, behold, Jesus met them, saying, "**Rejoice!**" So they came and held Him by the feet and worshiped Him.

Luke 1:14 And you will have joy and gladness, and many will **rejoice** at his birth.

Luke 1:28 And having come in, the angel said to her, "**Rejoice**, highly favored *one*, the Lord *is* with you; blessed *are* you among women!"

Luke 1:47 And my spirit
has **rejoiced** in God my Savior.

Luke 1:58 When her neighbors
and relatives heard how the Lord
had shown great mercy to her,
they **rejoiced** with her.

Luke 6:23 **Rejoice** in that day and
leap for joy! For indeed your
reward *is* great in heaven, For in
like manner their fathers did to the
prophets.

Luke 10:20 Nevertheless do
not **rejoice** in this, that the spirits

are subject to you, but
rather **rejoice** because your names
are written in heaven."

Luke 10:21 In that hour
Jesus **rejoiced** in the Spirit and
said, "I thank You, Father, Lord of
heaven and earth, that You have
hidden these things from *the* wise
and prudent and revealed them to
babes. Even so, Father, for so it
seemed good in Your sight.

Luke 13:17 And when He said
these things, all His adversaries

were put to shame; and all the multitude **rejoiced** for all the glorious things that were done by Him.

Luke 15:6 And when he comes home, he calls together *his* friends and neighbors, saying to them, '**Rejoice** with me, for I have found my sheep which was lost!'

Luke 15:9 And when she has found *it*, she calls *her* friends and neighbors together, saying,

'**Rejoice** with me, for I have found the piece which I lost!'

Luke 19:37 Then, as He was now drawing near the descent of the Mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to **rejoice** and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works they had seen,

John 3:29 He who has the bride is the bridegroom; but the friend of the bridegroom, who stands and hears him, **rejoices** greatly

because of the bridegroom's voice. Therefore this joy of mine is fulfilled.

John 4:36 And he who reaps receives wages, and gathers fruit for eternal life, that both he who sows and he who reaps may **rejoice** together.

John 5:35 He was the burning and shining lamp, and you were willing for a time to **rejoice** in his light.

John 8:56 Your father Abraham **rejoiced** to see My day, and he saw *it* and was glad."

John 14:28 You have heard Me say to you, 'I am going away and coming *back* to you.' If you loved Me, you would **rejoice** because I said, 'I am going to the Father,' for My Father is greater than I.

John 16:20 Most assuredly, I say to you that you will weep and lament, but the world will **rejoice**;

and you will be sorrowful, but your sorrow will be turned into joy.

John 16:22 Therefore you now have sorrow; but I will see you again and your heart will **rejoice**, and your joy no one will take from you.

Acts 2:26 Therefore my heart **rejoiced**, and my tongue was glad; Moreover my flesh also will rest in hope.

Acts 7:41 And they made a calf in those days, offered sacrifices to

the idol, and **rejoiced** in the works of their own hands.

Acts 15:31 When they had read it, they **rejoiced** over its encouragement.

Acts 16:34 Now when he had brought them into his house, he set food before them; and he **rejoiced**, having believed in God with all his household.

Romans 5:2 through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand,

and **rejoice** in hope of the glory of God.

Romans 5:11 And not only *that*, but we also **rejoice** in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation.

Romans 12:15 **Rejoice** with those who **rejoice**, and weep with those who weep.

Romans 15:10 And again he says: "**Rejoice**, O Gentiles, with His people!"

1 Corinthians 7:30 those who weep as though they did not weep, those who **rejoice** as though they did not **rejoice**, those who buy as though they did not possess,

1 Corinthians 12:26 And if one member suffers, all the members suffer with *it*; or if one member is honored, all the members **rejoice** with *it*.

1 Corinthians 13:6

does not **rejoice** in iniquity,
but **rejoices** in the truth;

2 Corinthians 7:7

and not only by his coming, but
also by the consolation with which
he was comforted in you, when he
told us of your earnest desire,
your mourning, your zeal for me,
so that I **rejoiced** even more.

2 Corinthians 7:9

Now I **rejoice**, not that you were
made sorry, but that your sorrow
led to repentance. For you were
made sorry in a godly manner,
that you might suffer loss from us
in nothing.

2 Corinthians 7:13

Therefore we have been
comforted in your comfort. And
we **rejoiced** exceedingly more for
the joy of Titus, because his spirit
has been refreshed by you all.

2 Corinthians 7:16 Therefore I **rejoice** that I have confidence in you in everything.

Galatians 4:27 For it is written:
“**Rejoice**, O barren, *You* who do not bear! Break forth and shout, *You* who are not in labor! For the desolate has many more children Than she who has a husband.”

Philippians 1:18 What then? Only *that* in every way, whether in pretense or in truth, Christ is

preached; and in this I **rejoice**, yes, and will **rejoice**.

Philippians 2:16 holding fast the word of life, so that I may **rejoice** in the day of Christ that I have not run in vain or labored in vain.

Philippians 2:17 Yes, and if I am being poured out *as a drink offering* on the sacrifice and service of your faith, I am glad and **rejoice** with you all.

Philippians 2:18 For the same reason you also be glad and **rejoice** with me.

Philippians 2:28 Therefore I sent him the more eagerly, that when you see him again you may **rejoice**, and I may be less sorrowful.

Philippians 3:1 Finally, my brethren, **rejoice** in the Lord. For me to write the same things to you *is* not tedious, but for you *it is* safe.

Philippians 3:3 For we are the circumcision, who worship God in the Spirit, **rejoice** in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh,

Philippians 4:4 **Rejoice** in the Lord always. Again I will say, **rejoice**!

Philippians 4:10 But I **rejoiced** in the Lord greatly that now at last your care for me has flourished again; though you surely did care, but you lacked opportunity.

Colossians 1:24 I now **rejoice** in my sufferings for you, and fill up in my flesh what is lacking in the afflictions of Christ, for the sake of His body, which is the church,

1 Thessalonians 3:9 For what thanks can we render to God for you, for all the joy with which we **rejoice** for your sake before our God,

1 Thessalonians 5:16
Rejoice always,

1 Peter 1:6 In this you greatly **rejoice**, though now for a little while, if need be, you have been grieved by various trials,

1 Peter 1:8 whom having not seen you love. Though now you do not see *Him*, yet believing, you **rejoice** with joy inexpressible and full of glory,

1 Peter 4:13 but **rejoice** to the extent that you partake of Christ's sufferings, that when His glory is

revealed, you may also be glad with exceeding joy.

2 John 1:4 I **rejoiced** greatly that I have found *some* of your children walking in truth, as we received commandment from the Father.

3 John 1:3 For I **rejoiced** greatly when brethren came and testified of the truth *that is* in you, just as you walk in the truth.

Revelation 11:10 And those who dwell on the earth will **rejoice** over them, make

merry, and send gifts to one another, because these two prophets tormented those who dwell on the earth.

Revelation 12:12

Therefore **rejoice**, O heavens, and you who dwell in them! Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and the sea! For the devil has come down to you, having great wrath, because he knows that he has a short time."

Revelation 18:20 "**Rejoice** over her, O heaven, and *you* holy apostles and prophets, for God has avenged you on her!"
